According to a <u>Media Release</u> from the <u>Virginia State Police</u>, Buchanan County Deputies Eric Dwayne Rasnake and Shane Earl Charles responded to a larceny in progress call on March 13, 2011. Randy Gilbert Newberry, armed with a high-powered rifle, shot both Rasnake and Charles multiple times as they were searching the area. The two were seriously wounded, but able to find cover and call for backup. Additional deputies and officers with the Virginia State Police arrived at the scene and were attempting to set up a search perimeter. Newberry then shot and killed Buchanan County Deputies Cameron Neil Justice and William Ezra Stiltner, before he was shot and killed by officers.
