Bristol Virginia Sheriff Jack Weisenburger announced the promotion of two veteran deputies in the Court Security Division of the Bristol Virginia Sheriffs Office. Joe Limburg has been promoted to the rank of Captain and Mike Stout has been promoted to the rank of Lieutenant.

Captain Limburg joined the Sheriffs Office in 1981 and has served various roles during his career including jail shift supervisor and court security officer.
