Visitation Hours and Regulations

Visiting hours are scheduled on Saturdays and Sundays. Designated visiting hours are as follows:

Males 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. Females 1:00 P.M. to 3:00 P.M.

Each inmate is generally allowed approximately thirty minutes of visitation once a week however, length of visitation may be affected by inmate population. Inmates serving weekends will not be allowed visitation. Extra visitation (one time) is allowed on the following holidays (News's Years, Fourth of July, Thanksgiving and Christmas) when they fall during the regular work week – Monday thru Friday.

- a. All visitors must register.
- b. All visitors must have proper identification with a picture.
- c. All children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
- d. All visitors are subject to search.
- e. Visitors who appear to be under the influence of intoxicants will not be allowed to visit, and may be subject to arrest.
- f. Failure to abide by these regulations may result in disciplinary action with loss of visitation privileges.

Inmates in disciplinary isolation (punitive isolation) may be denied visits. This restriction does not apply to attorneys, physicians, bondsmen or ministers.

Inmates placed in isolation for medical purposes, still retain the same privileges as those in administrative segregation and protective custody.
